US OF THE BREAST BILATERAL

CLINICAL HISTORY: Persistent palpable lymph node in the left axilla. Lumpy breasts, right greater than left.

TECHNIQUE: Ultrasound - Breast bilateral

COMPARISON: No previous ultrasound or mammogram available

FINDINGS:

Both breasts demonstrate with dense, partly shadowing parenchymal echotexture.

Right breast: no mass, cyst or other abnormality visualized.

Left breast: no mass, cyst or other abnormality visualized.

Palpable lump left axilla - benign-appearing lymph node with intact hilum and non-shadowing measuring 17 x 12 x 5 mm.

Right axillary lymph node, largest benign-appearing measures 17 x 11 x 5 mm.

IMPRESSION:

1. Unremarkable bilateral breasts BI-RADS category I.
2. Benign-appearing lymph nodes bilateral axillae, advise biopsy.
